Dear Mr. Gorland:

This letter is to request an agenda item be added to this week's City Council Meeting in reference to the Optimist Club BBQ Blast being held on the Circle on Saturday, January 21st, 2012.

On behalf of the Optimist Club, there are two matters that I respectfully ask be considered by the City Council:

First, to grant a permit so that the Club may sell beer, wine and mixed drinks on the Circle in conjunction with the event; and

Second, to request the Council consider granting funds in the amount of \$3000, as it has done in the past, to assist with the expenses for safety and sanitation associated with putting on the event. Last year's inaugural event was a tremendous success, and we look forward to building upon that success this year, and making this into a perennial community event of which the City can be proud.



We anticipate an estimated 25 teams and a turnout of 300 people. The event will be open to the public from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., however the teams will be allowed to set-up on the Circle beginning at 7:00 a.m.

POLICE/TRAFFIC: Based on the number of hours of the event, the estimated cost of off-duty officers is approximately \$1,960 based on 4 officers for a 14-hour period.

SANITATION: We are acquiring three port-o-lets at a cost of \$600, and a dumpster at a cost of \$375.

FYI, our additional costs include entertainment (both a DJ and a live local band, "Room Service") as well as bounce houses for the kids. We will also incur costs for rental of tables, chairs, and fire extinguishers (for safety).


