Business Façade Program

Refurbished buildings make the street a more pleasant place to stroll. Increased pedestrian traffic gives the neighborhood a vibrancy that is good for businesses and epitomizes what a downtown is supposed to be.

The CGA Team architects will provide architectural guidelines for business facades in Downtown Miami Springs and NW 36th Street.





Business Façade Program

- Match private funds to pay for improvements.
- Applicants may choose from one of the sample façade elevations that promote 1930s architectural styles that reflect Miami Springs's historical architecture: Pueblo or Streamline Moderne.

Three matching grants \$50,000 each (NW 36th Street
Three matching grants \$10,000 each (Downtown Miami Springs)




















Wayfinding and Signage Program




























































Street and Pedestrian Scale Lighting




